10. Provide evidence of posting of security fund as required in Section 8-4-12 of the Heyworth Right-of-Way Regulations Ordinance. _____
11. Provide any request for a variance from one or more provisions of this Chapter. (See Section 8-4-25 of the Heyworth Right-of-Way Regulations Ordinance. _____
12. New Electric, Communications, Telecommunications, Cable, Video Service, or Natural Gas Installations: If the work to be performed is for the installation of a new electric power, communications, telecommunications, cable television service, video service or natural gas distribution system, evidence that any "Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity" or other regulatory authorization that the applicant is required by law to obtain, or that the applicant has elect to obtain, has been issued by the ICC or other jurisdictional authority. _____

I (We) understand that if I (We) fail to address the improvements to put at acceptable standards that I (We) shall reimburse the Village of Heyworth for all costs incurred to remediate or address the issue to proper standards including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees and costs of suit to collect said costs.
